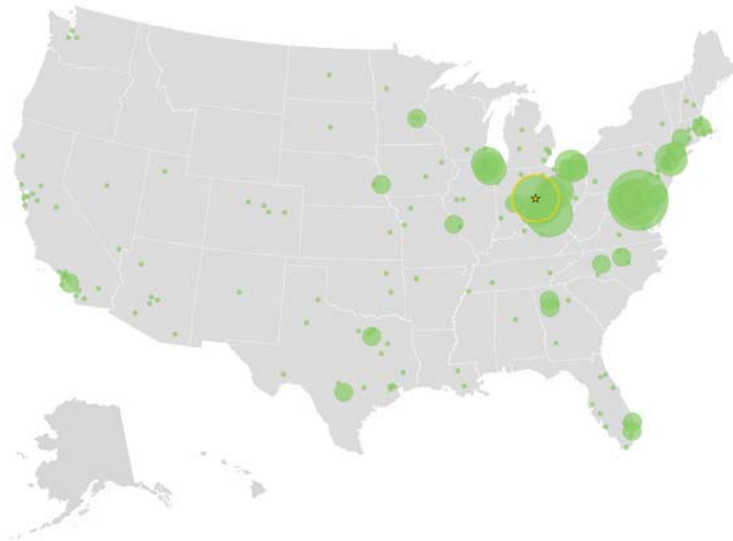

U.S. Senate candidates raise 51% of campaign funds
from outside their states

Remote Control

MapLight is a nonpartisan research group that tracks political money.

In this study, we examine out-of-state contributions received by the campaigns of candidates for the U.S. Senate in the upcoming 2012 election, as well as in the 2008 and 2010 elections. As of June 30, 2012, 51% of the itemized contributions in the 2012 senatorial election were from out-of-state sources. This is roughly consistent with figures from previous elections: In 2008, 60% came from out-of-state sources; in 2010 that number was 45%. So over the past three election cycles, a full 51% of all contributions to senatorial campaigns were made by people other than the candidates' constituents.

If money is equal to free speech, the rest of the country has a bigger say in selecting your senator than you do.

Funds Raised from Out-of-State

We examined contributions given to 180 candidates for the U.S. Senate. This included senators elected in 2008 and 2010, their major opponents in those races, and the prominent candidates for the 2012 election. All told, these candidates raised almost \$935 million in itemized campaign funds during the past five and a half years. Of those funds, \$478 million, or 51%, came from out-of-state; \$455 million, or 49%, came from in-state; and the remaining \$2 million (0.2%) could not be definitively located.

Other Findings

Sixty percent of all Senate candidates raised half or more of their campaign funds outside their home state (108 out of 180 candidates). Thirty percent of candidates (54 out of 180) raised two-thirds or more of their campaign funds from outside their state.

Only twenty-two percent of candidates (39 out of 180) raised at least two-thirds of their funds in-state.

The average percentage of funds each Senate candidate raised out-of-state is 53 percent, and the median percentage is 55 percent.

Methodology

Overview

This study examined campaign contributions to major candidates running for the U.S. Senate in November 2008 and 2010 as well as the upcoming general election in November 2012. MapLight used campaign contribution data from the Federal Election Commission.

Included Candidates

For this analysis, MapLight included contributions to 180 Senate candidates, covering the current or most recent races for all 100 Senate seats. We examined 57 candidates in 2008, 65 candidates in 2010, and the 58 top candidates in 2012 for a total of 180. We excluded candidates with less than \$100,000 in combined itemized contributions raised and self-contributions, as well as candidates who had not filed any campaign finance reports at the time this analysis was conducted.

In cases where there were more than two competitive candidates for a Senate seat, such as in Alaska in 2010, MapLight included more than two candidates. For consistency of comparison, MapLight excluded senators whose terms expire in 2013 and who are not continuing to seek election. One individual appears twice in this report: Linda McMahon, Republican candidate in Connecticut, who ran in 2010 and is running again in 2012. For this report, amounts for her 2010 and 2012 campaigns have been compiled separately. We also excluded senators appointed to office who did not subsequently run for reelection.

Included Contributions

MapLight analyzed contributions to each candidate's authorized campaign committees during the election cycle in which each most recently ran for Senate, using data from the Federal Election Commission. An election cycle is a two-year period as defined by the FEC, starting in January of a non-election year and ending in December of an election year. For example, the 2010 election cycle includes contributions from 2009 and 2010. For the current election cycle, contributions from Jan. 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012 are included. Returned contributions were deducted from contribution totals.

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Contributions from individuals, including contributions and loans from the candidates, were reported by the candidates' campaign committees. Contributions from PACs to candidates were taken from reports filed by the PACs.

MapLight did not include contributions to presidential campaign committees for candidates who also ran for president. MapLight included contributions and loans from a candidate to their own campaign (self-funding) and designated those funds as in-state. We excluded contributions from political parties, federal candidate PACs, and leadership PACs because they do not come from a clear geographic place. These three sources made up 5% of all contributions.

We excluded contributions from individuals contributing less than \$200 because they are not required to report address information. According to a report by the Center for Responsive Politics, for Senate candidates in the 2010 election these contributions made up an estimated 15% of all funds raised¹.

In-State/Out-of-State Determination

MapLight analyzed the sources of campaign contributions to candidates to determine the geographic origins of the contributions. Candidates are required to report to the Federal Election Commission the name and address of each individual donor who contributes \$200 or more. We used this address data to determine the state of origin for contributions from individuals. For contributions from political action committees (PACs), we used the address of each political action committee, as reported by the FEC. Individual contributions were 70% and PAC contributions were 18% of total itemized funds raised, while an additional 12% originated from the candidates themselves.

We counted contributions and loans from candidates themselves (self-funding) as in-state.

For 99.7% of itemized contributions, the address information reported was sufficient to identify a contribution as in-state or out-of-state.

In the following situations we categorized a contribution source as "Unknown:"

- Address information was blank or otherwise insufficient to locate contributor geographically.
- Contributor address did not correspond to any state. This included foreign addresses, non-U.S. located military bases, and U.S. territories.

Alternative method: We ran a second, alternative method of analysis on PAC contributions, using the geographic origins of the contributors to the PACs. In this alternative method, we divided the amount of contributions a PAC received from a candidate's home state by the total amount

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of contributions received by the PAC, to come up with a ratio that we then multiplied by the amount the candidate received from the PAC. For example, if a PAC received 10 percent of its contributions from the home state of a given candidate, a \$1,000 contribution to that candidate would be calculated as 10 percent in-state (\$100) and 90 percent out-of-state (\$900). MapLight also applied this methodology to contributions from one PAC to another. The results from this alternative method were similar to the results from the original method: across the three election cycles, 48% of funds originated from out-of-state contributions using the alternative method, compared with 51% using the original method. Because the results were similar between the two methods, we decided to use the original method throughout this report because it is easier to understand and explain.
